SNC-2018 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AWARD GUIDELINES

PURPOSE: The SNC-Scholarship Program was instituted in 2017 by the SNC Board of Directors to recognize and honor the accomplishments of a male and female member in good standing graduating from high school and going to college.

The purpose of the program is to offer financial aid to deserving SNC-ESA student surfers wishing to continue their education beyond secondary school level. These grants are awarded to ESA members on the basis of **academics** and **U.S. citizenship**, rather than athletic ability.

APPLICANTS MUST SATISFY THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

1. You must be an Eastern Surfing Association current member in good standing.
2. When filling out the application, print in ink or submit typewritten (preferred).
3. No application will be considered without an official school transcript. You should request your school(s) to send an official transcript(s) to the address below.
4. 4. Submit a letter of recommendation along with your application from a school staff member or business owner who will provide a letter of recommendation. The letter should be from someone who is not a member of your family.
5. Submit a short, (no more than 500 words) typewritten letter addressed to the SNC-Scholarship Committee detailing your future goals and how your choice of educational institutions that will help you reach your goals.
6. Application and all other pertinent information must be returned to the SNC-Scholarship Committee by June 15.

The application, along with the additional information you attach, will be used to determine your eligibility for an SNC-Scholarship Grant. You are advised to follow the directions above very carefully and submit all items required completely by the due date, otherwise the application will not be considered.

The SNC-Scholarship Committee will make a determination for awards no later than July 15 and recipients will be notified by August of the applicable school year.
